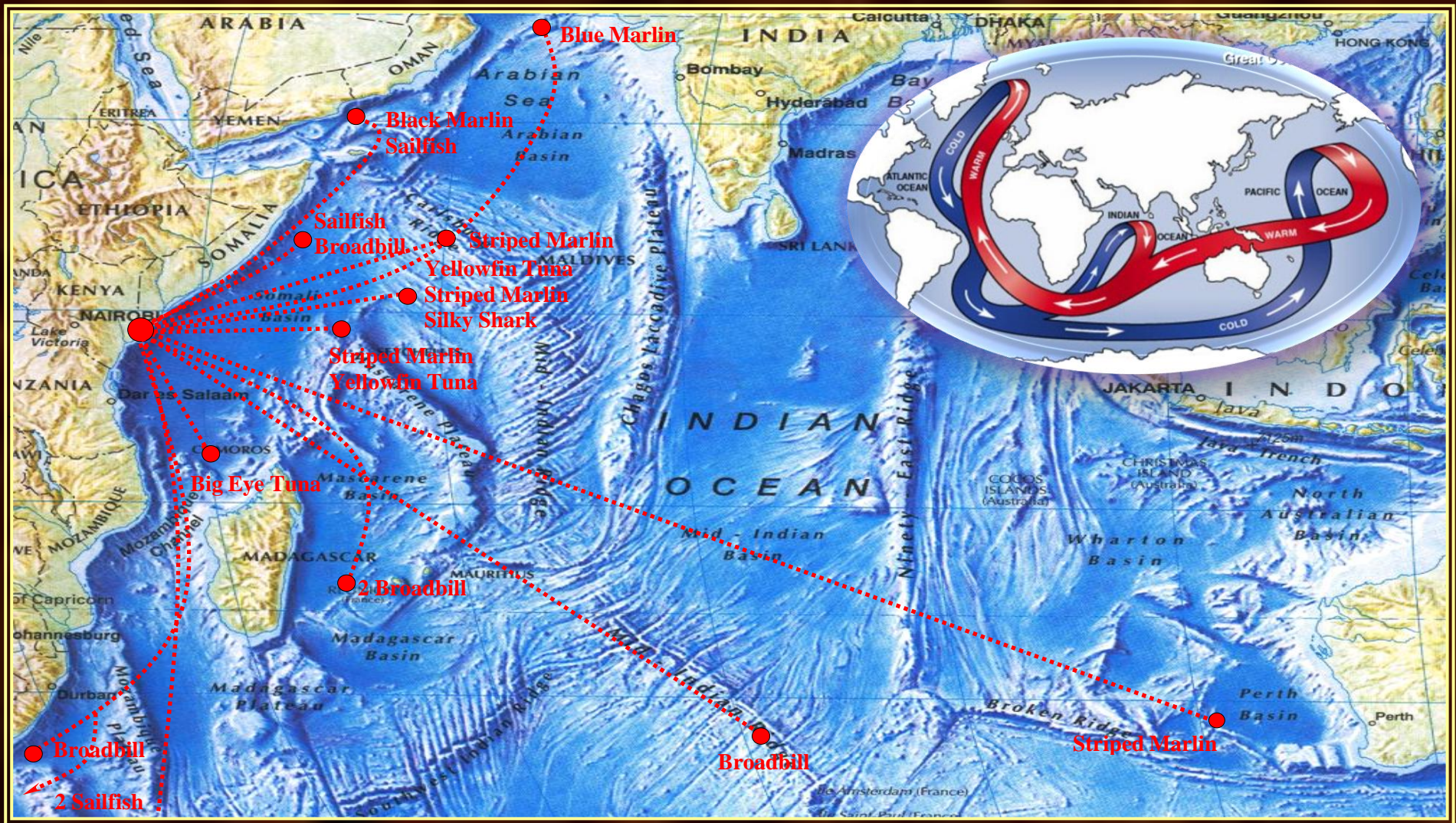


INTERNATIONAL RECOVERIES OF INTEREST



International recoveries above, a striped marlin tagged on the Rips and re-caught off Perth, Australia traveling 5250 miles in just 195 days, a broadbill tagged on the NKB and re-caught on the Mid Indian Ridge traveling 3600 miles, a blue marlin re-caught off Iran traveling 2620 miles in 249 days, another broadbill tagged off the NKB was re-caught off Port Elizabeth, South Africa traveling 2400 miles in 1 year 6 days and a black marlin tagged off Watamu and re-caught off Yemen traveling 1880 miles in 159 days. A sailfish recaptured by a commercial trawler on the Atlantic Indian Ridge traveling 3923 miles. The only long range recovery reported in 2010 was a sailfish caught off Cape Town, South Africa, 2 years after Eclare had tagged it in Ziwayu. Insert is the Great Ocean Conveyor Belt.
